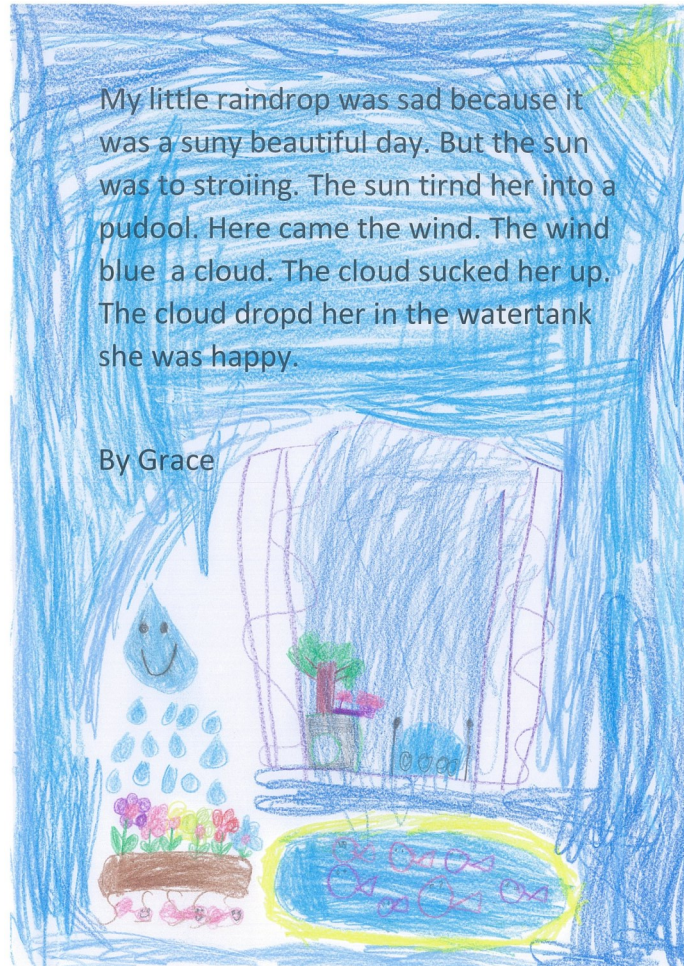

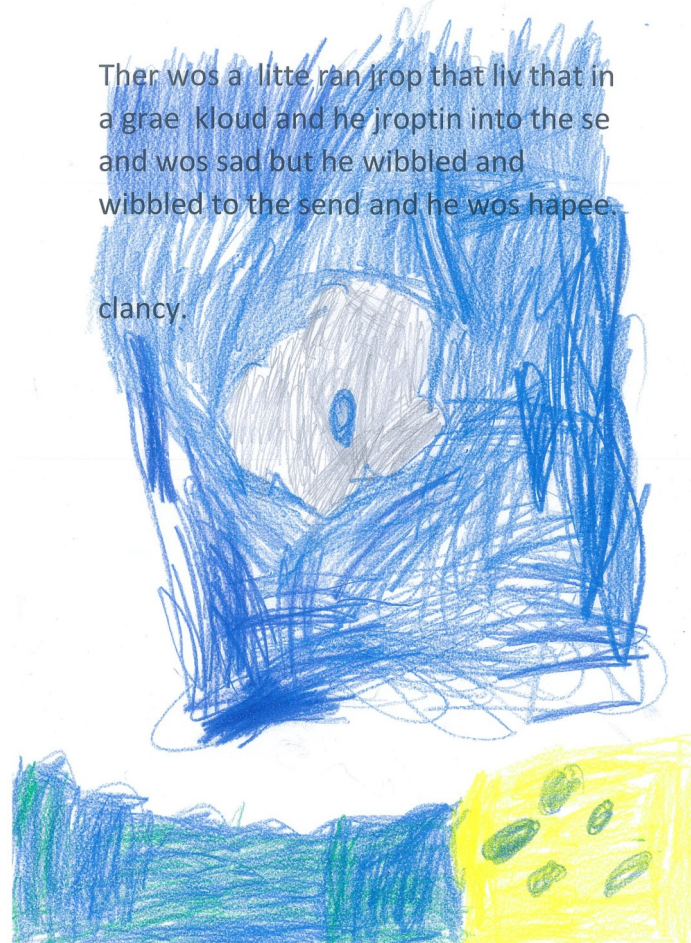

He was a sad raindrop because he was alone and he had no frieneds. he fell out a cloud into the sea and he was happy Again. The raindrop slid off the Shore.

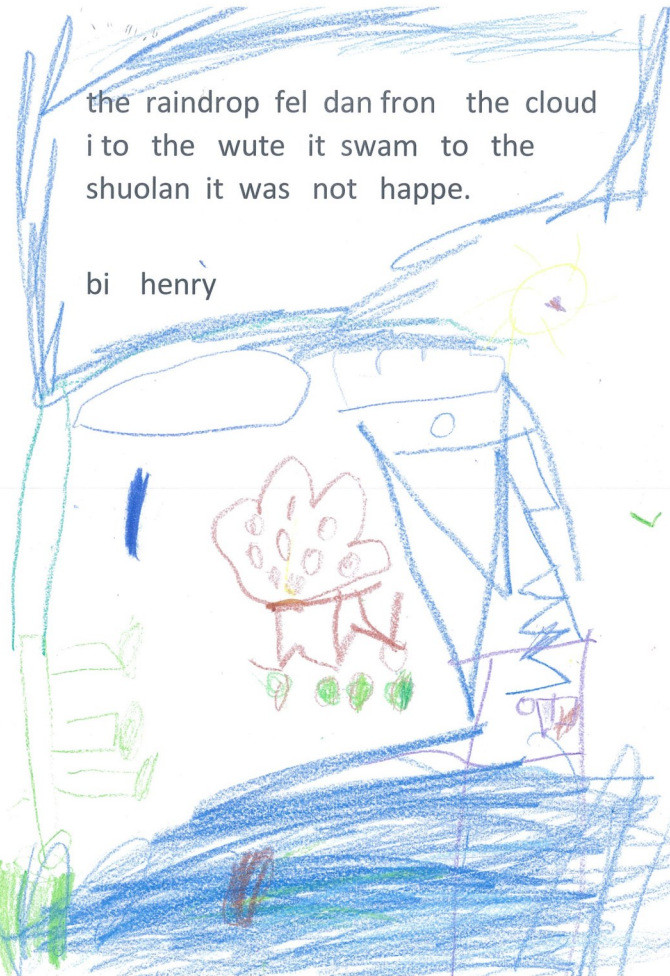
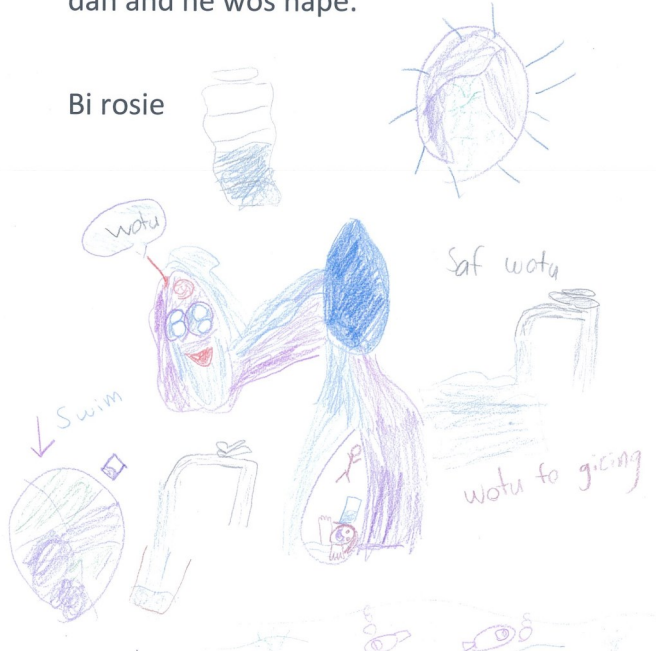
